AHSC AWARDS BOOST HOUSING, TRANSIT, INFRASTRUCTURE The Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) program last week awarded nearly \$30 million to Fruitvale Transit Village Phase IIB (above), a joint development of The Unity Council and BRIDGE Housing that will create 181 affordable, transit-oriented homes in Oakland, including 46 units of permanent supportive housing. BRIDGE's Potrero Block B, a HOPE-SF development of 157 affordable apartments, received a similar allocation. AHSC is administered by the Strategic Growth Council and implemented by the California Department of Housing and Community Development. The competitive grants are awarded to projects that help create holistic communities with affordable housing and transportation options near jobs and other key



services.
