On June 5, BRIDGE celebrated the ceremonial groundbreaking of the first phase of new residential construction at Jordan Downs in Los Angeles consisting of 115 rental apartments in 12 buildings. The Jordan Downs master-plan, created by the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) and codeveloped by BRIDGE Housing and The Michaels Organization, is a multi-phased redevelopment project that when complete will encompass over 1,400 units, along with community facilities, retail, open space, and neighborhood programs and services to improve the lives of current and future generations. in El Cerrito received unanimous Planning Commission approval on July 12. El Cerrito's first GreenTRIP-certified development will bring 223 new housing units, 30% of which are affordable, to a parcel directly adjacent to the El Cerrito del Norte BART station, which has been used as a surface parking lot for the station. The development will also include over 8,700 square feet of commercial space for neighborhood-serving retail.
