With the boost of a Stein Scholarship from BRIDGE, Shane Allen was able to complete his undergraduate degree. He maintained a 3.9 GPA while juggling a part-time job and a family. Shane went on to earn a Master's in neuroscience from the University of Pennsylvania and now works as a project manager in the clinical trials field. He and his family live in Northwest Arkansas, where they plan to build a home. Shane credits BRIDGE and the scholarship for a large part of his success.
