





OUR IMPACT

- BRIDGE scholarship programs reduce financial strain and stress on scholars and their families
- 98% of BRIDGE Scholars worry less about money
- 86% of BRIDGE Scholars take out fewer student loans

BRIDGE scholarship programs support scholars in pursuing and finishing their education

- 97% of BRIDGE Scholars have more time to focus on their studies
- 52% of BRIDGE Scholars have already completed their programs and 39% are on their way to completion
- "I had exhausted all [possible] grants and loans... Without the scholarship I don't think I could have finished my degree program."
